

~ MURAL CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS ~

Wall murals may be cleaned with warm water, a bit of mild soap (such as Dawn, well-diluted) and a soft sponge. Two rules of thumb: *never use abrasive scrubbers* or cleaners of any kind (such as steel wool or bathroom cleaning products) as permanent scratching may occur. Also, never clean with bleach products or solvents as these may permanently affect the coloring on your mural.

When cleaning, always start from the *bottom* and work your way up. This prevents dirty water running down the mural. Use two buckets, one with cleaning solution & one empty bucket to wring dirty water into. Work with a damp, not dripping, sponge or brush, taking care not to over-wet the mural.

Once the surface has been cleaned with the mild, soapy water, "rinse" the surface with a damp, clean sponge dipped in plain water. Once clean, blots dry with a soft, lint-free cloth. Always wipe in the direction of the brush strokes, as much as possible. If using a soft-bristled brush on build up, brush carefully and not too hard as it could damage your mural.

Remember the old saying that an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure. Keep your walls, floors and furniture clean and dust free & remind the little ones to keep their hands off the walls, especially the wall mural! ☺

Things you'll need:

- Sponges (non-abrasive)
- Liquid Dish Soap
- Soft-bristled Brush (if heavy build up)
- Terry Cloth Towels
- 2 Buckets
